POLICY DOCUMENTATION

JUNIOR REPRESENTATION - TOURNAMENT CODE OF CONDUCT (Year 5/6 – U/17)

- 1/ MCCA Junior Representation Code of Conduct will apply at all times
- 2/ MCCA tournament players are responsible to team manager and coach at all times
- 3/ Tournament rules will be agreed beforehand by the manager, coach and players
- 4/ MCCA tournament players that break tournament rules will be responsible to the manager and coach, who will deal with it accordingly
- 5/ Exceptional circumstances (at the discretion of the manager and coach), will result in non-selection of players and the possibility of players being sent home
- 6/ Broken codes of conduct will be reported to the CEO as soon as possible and subsequently to the Board of Control

Mid Canterbury Cricket Association expects the very highest standards of behaviour on and off the field at all times. Non compliance with these policy guidelines will be considered totally unacceptable. The policy guidelines are to support and protect all parties concerned with junior representative tournaments.
