POLICY DOCUMENTATION

SCHOOL \rightarrow CLUB PATHWAYS (4 th /5 th GRADE)	

- 1/ Defined paths should be adopted, interlinking specific schools with specific cricket clubs
- 2/ Teachers, coaches, parents and pupils will be fully aware of which club links in with which school
- 3/ Children can join clubs their friends from school are/will be joining
- 4/ Parents and teachers can assist their local club in promoting/supporting junior cricket
- 5/ Player poaching will be discouraged
- 6/ Exceptions will be accepted, if a player's residential address conflicts with their school area, (ie. Living in Ashburton, but schooling in Wakanui)
- 7/ School → club pathways is particularly for development purposes and will not affect secondary schooling years
- 8/ All clubs can develop junior sections

The entire school \rightarrow club area is as important as any aspect of cricket development in Mid Canterbury and a known pathway will assist all clubs in generating junior sections and it will assist all schools in directing their pupils to a club they have knowledge and awareness of.

The broader the base of junior cricket the greater the likely strength of senior/second grade cricket clubs.
